



The inner image represents the seam line.

The outer image represents the cut line.

There's no need to make a template for each. If your printer prints the outer line, use that image to cut fabric and sew your eye mask with a 1/2 inch seam.

If your printer does not reproduce the outermost line, use the inner line and add a 1/2" seam allowance around all sides.

This is a very fluid item -- don't obsess about exact seam allowances. Come as close as you can and the results will be fine.
